VMware vSphere - The Post-Broadcom Crisis

VMware vSphere under Broadcom has undergone drastic changes that have made the solution unsustainable for many organizations: elimination of perpetual licenses, price increases up to 1000%, and core-based licensing with mandatory 16-core minimums per CPU.

Critical Comparison: Where NexaVM Triumphs Over VMware

1. Licensing and Pricing - The Broadcom Disaster

NexaVM - Sustainable Economic Model

- Perpetual licenses available** without forced lock-in
- 60-70% TCO reduction** compared to post-Broadcom VMware
- No artificial minimum core requirements**
- Transparent pricing** without surprises

VMware - The Broadcom Debacle

- Complete elimination of perpetual licenses** (2024)
- 150-1000% price increases** for many customers
- Subscription-only** with mandatory 3-5 year contracts
- 20% penalty** for late renewals

2. Migration and Operational Continuity

NexaVM - Seamless VMware Migration

- Integrated migration tool** for agentless migration from VMware
- Automatic V2V conversion** without downtime
- 95% compatibility** with VM lifecycle functions
- Familiar interface** reduces required training
- Heterogeneous support** for simultaneous VMware/KVM



✗ VMware - Forced Vendor Lock-in

- No support** for migration to alternatives
- Increasingly stringent** technological lock-in
- High exit costs** for platform changes

3. Performance and Scalability

✓ NexaVM - Proven Enterprise Performance

- 100,000+ VMs** supported per cluster
- VM creation:** 100 VMs in 11 seconds
- 10,000+ hosts** manageable from single management node
- No performance degradation** with scale

✗ VMware - Hidden Performance Issues

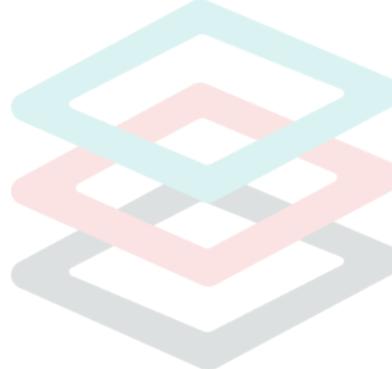
- CPU ready time** problems with over-provisioning
- Memory ballooning** impact on performance
- Network bottlenecks** in large deployments
- Significant virtualization overhead** for CPU-intensive workloads



Post-Broadcom Strategic Recommendation

Migrate to NexaVM IMMEDIATELY if:

- VMware renewal** expiring in 2025-2026
- IT budget** under pressure from VMware increases
- Strategic independence** from mega-vendors required
- Performance optimization** necessary
- Long-term cloud strategy** planned
